<input type="checkbox"/> 1	Normal No aggressive behavior present
<input type="checkbox"/> 2	Borderline aggressive behavior Aggressive behaviors are few and only intermittently present. There is no interference in functioning or no interference in the participant's usual and occupational roles
<input type="checkbox"/> 3	Mild aggressive behavior Few or mild aggressive behaviors of illness with effective functioning or very little interference in participant's usual and occupational roles
<input type="checkbox"/> 4	Moderate aggressive behavior Some prominent aggressive behaviors with some interference in the level of daily functioning
<input type="checkbox"/> 5	Marked aggressive behavior Significant aggressive behaviors with very substantial interference in the participant's usual roles
<input type="checkbox"/> 6	Severe aggressive behavior Very marked aggressive behaviors. Participant is unable to function in most areas of daily activities
<input type="checkbox"/> 7	Extreme aggressive behavior Extreme aggressive behaviors. Participant is completely incapacitated and requires extra care and supervision
